- 4. Incentives Re-directing Public and Private (CAR, ABC, Supply Chain, Consumers)
- 5. Closing the agricultural frontier, with a viable productive sector. Caquetá-
- 6. "It's not the cow's fault".
- 7. SANAR. Soil, Water, Nature, Associations, Restoration.

Responses: Sustainable Intensification

- Healthy soils
- Resource efficiency
- Integration of natural habitat
- Resilience to climate change
- Produce more from as little as possible not less
- Increase yields and improve environmental outcomes



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- 2050: 9 bn people, 60% + Supply, only 12% + Arable Land
- 1/3 Freshwater, 28% of World's Land with Medium to High Potential for Sustainable Expansion of Cultivated Area. 60% of the forest still remains.
- 60% of Soybeans, 45% of Sugar and Coffee, 44% of Beef, 42% Poultry, 33% Maize, 70% Bananas
- IDB (2014): "Carefully Selecting new land for cultivation and conserving the land and water already being used must be a central component of agricultural policy and practice"

Improving practices for beef production and crops Partnering with the private sector to promote change Building relationships with research organizations




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LATIN AMERICA SOLUTIONS

Biodiversity Index by Land Use




